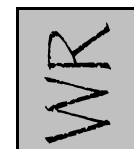

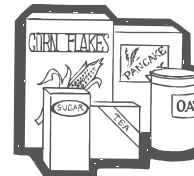
**7/25: Good Bye Party for Brandon & J'Lae** – We will meet in Annex A after evening assembly to honor the work of Brandon & J'Lae.
