Anx A “Staying True to The True Messiah” **Barry Day**

Anx A “52 Lessons on Living a Christ Centered Life” **Barry Day**
This two-volume book set of Luke and Acts is a total of 52 chapters. It breaks down easily into one chapter per week for a year.
